Description	HNF4gamma(NR2A3) is a member of orphan receptors. The expression is observed in pancreas, kidney, small intestine, and testis, with no expression detected in liver. The level is lesser than 10% of the HNF4 alpha.

Origin	Produced in BALB/c mouse ascites after inoculation with hybridoma of mouse myeloma cells (NS-1) and spleen cells derived from a BALB/c mouse immunized with Baculovirus-expressed recombinant human HNF4 gamma (91-212 aa) .
Specificity	This antibody specifically recognizes human HNF4 gamma and cross reacts with rat HNF4 gamma. This antibody does not recognize human HNF4 alpha. Not yet tested in other species.
Purification	Ammonium sulfate fractionation.
Formulation	Physiologic saline with 0.1 % NaN3.

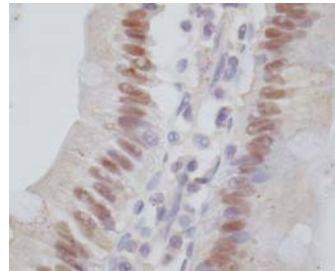
