Description	Pentraxins are a superfamily of conserved proteins characterized by the pentraxin domain. CRP and SAP are recognized as classical short pentraxins, whereas Pentraxin3(PTX3) belongs to the long pentraxins. CRP and SAP are induced in the liver in response to IL-6. In contrast, PTX3 is produced by a variety of tissues and cells, such as vascular endothelial cells, macrophages, and neutrophils, predominantly in response to proinflammatory signals (bacterial products, IL-1, and TNF).

Origin	Produced in BALB/c mouse ascites after inoculation with hybridoma of mouse myeloma cells (NS-1) and spleen cells derived from a mouse immunized with recombinant human PTX3 (18-381 aa).
Epitope	18-79 a.a.
Specificity	This antibody specifically recognizes human PTX3. Not yet tested in other species.
Purification	Ammonium sulfate fractionation.
Formulation	Physiological saline with 0.1% NaN ₃ as a preservative.

Application / Recommended Concentration

In order to obtain the best results, optimal working dilutions should be determined by each individual user.
