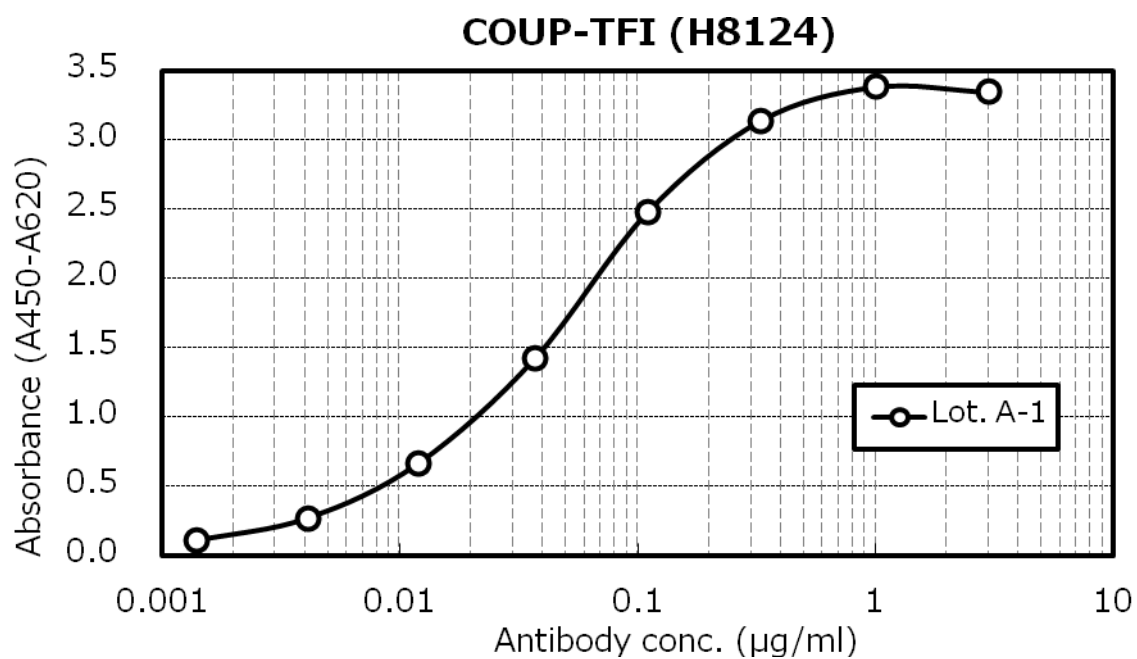

**Validation Data**

Method: Each 1 micro gram per well of antigen was coated on an ELISA plate for overnight at 4°C. Blocking with non-fat dry milk incubated for one hour at room temperature. After washing plate, Serial diluted antibody solution was loaded on each well at room temperature. Washed Plate was incubated with HRP conjugated anti-mouse IgG (Amersham, 1:15,000), then washed and visualized with TMB reagent.
